DISPOSAL OF APPLIANCES

Before disposing any old appliance, please remove any plugs and cut the power leads to ensure that the appliance is inoperative.

Remove the door but leave the shelves in place to prevent children climbing inside.

Dispose of your Wine Cellar packaging properly. Ensure that any plastic wrappings, bags etc. are disposed of safely and kept out of the reach of babies and young children. Danger of suffocation!



This symbol indicates that it must not be discarded as general household waste.

Instead, it should be handed over to the applicable collection point for the recycling of electrical and electronic equipment. Disposal must be carried out in accordance with local environmental regulations for waste disposal.

By disposing of this product correctly you will help prevent potential negative consequences for the environment and human health, which would otherwise be caused by inappropriate waste handling of this product.

Refrigeration equipment must be properly disposed of in a professional and appropriate way, in accordance with the current local regulations and laws which protects the environment this applies to your old Wine Cellar and to your new Wine Cellar once it has reached the end of its service life.

BEFORE INSTALLING AND USING YOUR NEW APPLIANCE

Warning: Before powering up the appliance, please open the door for 5 minutes to ventilate the cabinet. Read through the instruction manual supplied with the appliance – failure to install or use this appliance in accordance with the instruction manual may invalidate any warranty.

The manufacturer does not accept any liability for damage caused through improper use or incorrect installation.

Do not install this appliance if it has been damaged during transportation. This includes the plug and power cord.

Please keep this instruction manual in a safe place for future reference.

Note: This appliance is intended to be used exclusively for the storage of wine only.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using an electrical Wine Cellar, basic precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons, including the following:

- . To prevent damage to the door and door gasket, make sure the door is fully opened before pulling out any shelves.
- . Do not move the wine cellar when it is loaded with wine, you might distort the appliance.
- . If the power lead becomes damaged, it should only be replaced by the manufacturer or a qualified person.
- . Never allow children to operate, play with, or crawl inside the appliance.
- . Never clean appliance parts with flammable fluids.
- . Do not store or use gasoline or any other flammable vapors and liquids in the vicinity of this or any other appliance. This will cause a fire hazard or explosion.

Warning:

- . Do not allow the refrigerant circuit to become damaged while using or installing the appliance. Should it become damaged, do not use the appliance until you are instructed to do so by service engineer. Refrigerant can ignite or cause damage to the eye when leakage.
- . Always remember to unplug the appliance before cleaning. When disconnecting from the electricity supply, pull the plug, not the power cord.
- . Do not use anything electrical inside the wine cellar.
- . All electrical repairs must be carried out by a qualified service engineer. Inadequate repairs may result in a major source of danger for the user and invalidate any warranty.
- . Never store anything dangerous inside the appliance, such as combustibles, explosives, strong acid, or alkali etc.
- . Always keep any ventilation openings clear of obstruction. Should they become blocked, clear them straight away.
- . Make sure that the plug is in an accessible place when installation is complete.
- . Only use this appliance for domestic purposes in accordance with these instructions.
- . Do not connect or disconnect the electric plug when your hands are wet.
- . The wine cellar is suitable for storing wine only. It is not suitable for storing fresh or frozen foods.

To avoid contamination of wine, please respect the following instructions:

- . Opening the door for long periods can cause a significant increase of the temperature in the compartments of the appliance.
- . Clean the surfaces that have contact with bottles regularly.
- . If the refrigerating appliance is left empty for long periods, switch off, defrost, clean, dry, and leave the door open to prevent mold developing within the appliance.
- . If the refrigerant of these appliances is R600a, flammable and explosive articles should not be put in or near the cabinet, to avoid the fire or explode caused.

Warning:

- . This appliance cannot be used by children aged from 8 years and below and persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have not been given supervision or not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision. Children are not allowed to load and unload wine cellar.



INSTALLATION OF YOUR WINE CELLAR

Before Using Your Wine Cellar

- . Remove the exterior and interior packing.
- . Before connecting the Wine cellar to the power source, let it stand upright for approximately 2 hours. This will reduce the possibility of a malfunction in the cooling system from handling during transportation.
- . Check that the voltage marked on the product corresponds with your supply voltage.
- . Clean the interior surface with lukewarm water using a soft cloth.
- . When replace the illuminating lamp, please contact local service provider for replacement.
- . When disposing your appliance, please choose an authorized disposal site.

Installation of Your Wine Cellar

- . Place your Wine cellar on a floor that is strong enough to support it when it is fully loaded. To level your Wine cellar, adjust the front leveling leg at the bottom of the Wine cellar.
- . Locate the Wine cellar away from direct sunlight and sources of heat (stove, heater, radiator, etc.). Direct sunlight may affect the acrylic coating and heat sources may increase electrical consumption. Extreme cold ambient temperatures may also cause the unit not to perform properly.
- . Avoid locating the unit in moist areas.
- . Plug the Wine cellar into an exclusive, properly installed-grounded wall outlet. Do not under any circumstances cut or remove the third (ground) prong from the power cord. Any questions concerning power and/or grounding should be directed toward a certified electrician or an authorized service center.
- . **Important:** If the lowest temperature is set during periods of high humidity and ambient temperature, condensation may appear on outside surfaces and the door of wine cellar, this is a normal phenomenon.

ATTENTION:

This wine cellar has been designed for freestanding and built under installation. In every case, there must be adequate ventilation and access for service.


Freestanding installation will allow you to install the wine cellar in almost any indoor place you desired. You must follow the stated instructions for electrical requirements, recommended install area and leveling of the wine cellar.

BUILT-UNDER INSTALLATION


When installing the wine cellar under the counter, follow the recommended spacing dimensions shown.

Always keep any ventilation openings clear of obstruction.



OPERATING YOUR WINE CELLAR

CONTROL PANEL



The temperature setting can be adjusted from 5 °C to 20 °C.



To control the appliance turn on/off.

Press to turn on the control panel backlight buttons if they are off.

To turn off your wine cellar for cleaning or extended absence, press the power button once.

After the unit beeps once, hold the power button for 10 seconds and your wine cellar will shut itself Off. Once the wine cellar has been turned off, please allow at least 5 seconds before starting up again.

This will limit excessive wear on the compressor.



To control the interior light ON or OFF.

Interior Lighting ON/OFF Control.




Used to raise(warm) the temperature in 1 °C.

The screen is set to display the actual temperature, press this button to increase the temperature by 1 °C.



Used to lower(cool) the temperature in 1 °C.

The screen is set to display the actual temperature, press this button to decrease the temperature by 1 °C.



Temperature setting.

Press to select Upper/ Lower zone for setting temperature. The digital display flashes to inform the accessibility to adjust setting.



To show the setting temperature of the wine cellar.

-  : Lights up while compressor is running, goes out while compressor stops, and flashes while system is in defrosting..
-  : Lights up while PTC heater is working.
-  : Lights up while in lock state, and goes out while in unlock state.

Control Panel Power Saving Mode (Please notice the function will impact to your user experience, read carefully before activated)

Under Control Panel standby status, Please C & F button for 3 seconds, buzzer will alert with Beep sound. It will entry to power saving On/Off mode status, and indicate at bottom left corner.

ON for indicate constantly, OF means control panel will off in 1 minute after the background light automatically goes off from the screen. All light will show in same color as the unit connect the power at first time without press any keys. Under ON mode, Button background light off within 15 seconds automatically but display panel remain light on.

For OF Mode, Button background light off within 15 seconds automatically and display panel will off automatically within 60 Seconds.

Note:

- A. With the unit connected power and ON status, tap any button when all the lights off, the buzzer will beeps once and the background lights and digital screen will lights on.
- B. As connected power and under standby mode, the background light below the power button will flash every 2 seconds.

OTHER FUNCTIONS

⊕ To switch between °C and °F

Press to alter the temperature display in Fahrenheit or Celsius

⊕ Attention

If the unit is unplugged, power lost, or turned off, you must wait 3 to 5 minutes before restart the unit. If you need attempt to restart before this time delay, the wine cellar will not start.

For first time use or longer absence of using, the temperature will difference between setting and LED display temperature. After running a certain period, the temperature will be reverted.

⊕ Temperature Memory Function

If the power is suddenly lost, the set temperature will be saved by the unit.

Once the power is back on, the unit will be at the same actual temperature.

⊕ Door Lock

Your unit is provided with a lock and key combination.

The keys are located inside the plastic bag that contains the instruction manual. Insert the key into the lock and turn it counterclockwise to unlock the door. To lock the door, do the reverse operation making sure metal pin is engaged completely. Remove the key and place it in a secure place for safekeeping.


Important: If the lowest temperature is set during periods of high humidity and ambient temperature, condensation may appear on outside surfaces and the door of wine cellar, this is a normal phenomenon. This condensation will disappear once humidity levels drop. To prevent, it is recommended to install the appliance with sufficient ventilation in a dry and/or an air-conditioned room. Please ensure that doors are closing and sealing properly.

⊕ **To remove the shelves:**

Before removing a telescopic shelf from the appliance, it is necessary to remove all the bottles on the Shelf.


Pull out the shelf to align the shelf grooves to the stoppers fixed on the inside cabinet.

Push upward the shelf from the telescopic rails and remove it carefully.




How to take out the Wine Basket:

- Step 1: Pull out the Wine Basket to the limit;
- Step 2 : Press down the Stopper Rod;
- Step 3: Pull out the Wine Basket completely.



⊕ About the door support pad

Do not remove the door support pad in daily use. The door support pad is used for preventing the sagging of the door. If the lower edge of the door has scratched the door support pad, please contact the service center for handling, it is important to avoid poor sealing caused wine cellar temperature inaccuracy.



CARE & MAINTENANCE

⊕ **Clean your wine cellar**

Turn off the power, unplug the appliance, and remove all items including shelves.

Wash the inside surfaces with a warm water and diluted mild detergent.

Wash the shelves with a diluted mild detergent.

Wring excess water out of the sponge or cloth when cleaning area of the controls, or any electrical parts.

Wash the outside cabinet with warm water and diluted mild liquid detergent.

Rinse well and wipe dry with a clean, soft cloth.

⊕ **Power failure**

Most power failures are corrected within a few hours and should not affect the temperature of your appliance if you minimize the number of times the door is opened. If the power is going to be off for a long period of time, you need to take the proper steps to protect your contents.

⊕ **Vacation Time**

Leave the wine cellar operating during vacations of less than three weeks.

If the appliance will not be used for more than three months, remove all items and turn off the appliance. Clean and dry the interior thoroughly. To prevent odor and mold growth, leave the door open slightly, blocking it open if necessary.

Make sure there will be no children and animals climb into the appliance.

⊕ **Moving your wine cellar**

Remove all items.

Take out the loose items inside the wine cellar (such as shelf) or fix the loose items with the foam.

Turn the adjustable leg up to the base to avoid damage.

Tape the door shut.

Be sure the appliance stays secure in the upright position during transportation. Also protect outside of appliance with a blanket or similar item.

⊕ **Energy saving tips**

The wine cellar should be located in the coolest area of the room, away from heat producing appliances, and out of the direct sunlight.

Set temperature according to the characteristics of your wine to maximize energy saving.

⊕ **Charcoal filter**

The Charcoal filter is located in the back of compartment.


Replace it with a new one once a year with properly use.

It can be purchased from your dealer or from the Spare Parts Department.

☞ Remove the shelf in front of the filter.

☞ Grip the filter and turn it 90° clockwise or anti-clockwise to remove.

☞ Insert the new filter in the vertical position and turn it 90° clockwise or anti-clockwise until it clicks into position.



PROBLEMS WITH YOUR WINE CELLAR


You can solve common problems by reading the suggestions below to save the cost of a possible service call. Try to see if you solve the problem before calling the service.

Troubleshooting Guide


Problem	Possible Cause
Wine cellar does not operate	No plugged in. The appliance is turned off. The circuit breaker tripped or a blown fuse.
Wine cellar is not cold enough	Check the temperature control setting. External environment may require a higher setting. The door is always opened. The door is not closed completely. The door gasket does not seal properly.
Turns on and off frequently	The room temperature is hotter than normal. Overload of the cabinet The door is always opened. The door is not closed completely. The temperature control is not set correctly. The door gasket does not seal properly.
The light does not work	Not plugged in. The circuit breaker tripped or a blown fuse. The lightbulb has burned out. The light button is "OFF"
Abnormal vibrations	Check to sure that the Wine cellar is level.
Too much noise	The rattling noise may come from the flow of the refrigerant, which is normal. As each cycle ends, you may hear gurgling. Contraction and expansion of the inside walls may cause popping and crackling noises. The wine cellar is not level.
The door will not close properly	The wine cellar is not level. The door was reversed and not properly installed. The gasket is dirty. The shelves are out of position.

安裝酒櫃

使用酒櫃之前

- 拆除酒櫃內外包裝。
- 在酒櫃連接到電源前或移動後，讓它直立大約 2 小時。這將減少冷卻系統發生故障的可能。
- 檢查產品上標記的電壓是否與您的電源電壓相符。
- 用溫水軟布清潔機內表面。
- 當更換照明燈，請聯絡經銷商檢查維修。
- 當您棄置設備，請選擇當地法例指定的棄置場所。

安裝酒櫃

- 請將您的酒櫃放在一個足夠承托滿載酒櫃的樓層結構上。並在使用前調整酒櫃底部機腳以平衡您的酒櫃。
- 把酒櫃放到遠離陽光直接照射的地方和熱源（爐灶，加熱器，散熱器等）。陽光直射可能會影響塗料及機內溫度，熱源可能會增加耗電量及對存酒造成影響。極端寒冷的環境溫度也可能會導致機器不正確運作。
- 避免放到潮濕的地區。
- 正確安裝接地插座並連接酒櫃電源。在任何情況下，不要剪掉或移除電線。任何有關電力連接及操作，應該交由合資格的電工或代理商產品服務中心處理。
- **重要：設定溫度時注意如於高溫或高濕度環境下設定最低溫度，機身及櫃門玻璃會形成冷凝水，此為正常環境影響現象。**







控制面板節能模式 (請注意此功能會影響使用體驗，啓動前請參考以下說明)

在鎖屏狀態下按動攝氏(C)/華氏(F)轉換鍵3秒，蜂鳴器會發出提示聲BEEP。接著會進入或者退出節能模式，顯示屏左下方出現ON或OF字體。ON表示恒定亮燈，OF表示控制面板在背景燈自動熄滅後1分鐘關掉；

首次連接電源後所有顯示燈均顯示同一種顏色，在ON模式下，如果不按動任何鍵，按鍵背景燈會於15秒後自動熄滅。顯示屏上仍然恒定亮燈。在OF模式下，如果不按動任何鍵，按鍵背景燈於15秒內同時自動熄滅。顯示屏則於60秒鐘內同時自動熄滅。

備注:

- A. 在連接電源及開機狀態下且全部顯示燈未有亮著時觸動任何按鍵，蜂鳴器會發出提示聲，而背景燈及數碼屏則回復亮著狀態；

本機配有門鎖和鑰匙。鑰匙位於包含使用指南的包裝袋內。



從導軌上向上推層架並小心地將其卸下。





⊗ 關閉門托

請勿在日常使用中拆下門托，門托的作用是預防櫃門下垂。如果櫃門的下沿時常刮到了門托，請聯繫服務中心作出妥善處理，以免酒櫃密封不良導致儲存溫度不準確。

🕒 清潔酒櫃

關閉電源，拔下電源插頭，然後取出所有物品，包括酒架。
用溫水和溫和稀釋清潔劑清潔機內表面。
用溫和和稀釋的清潔劑清潔酒架。
清潔控制顯示屏或任何電氣部件的區域時，請將多餘的水從海綿或布上擰乾方可清潔。
用溫水和中性液體洗滌劑清洗外殼，然後用乾淨的軟布擦乾。

🕒 電源故障

如果將打開櫃門的次數減至最少，大多數電源故障會在幾小時內得到糾正，並且不會影響設備的溫度。如果要長時間關閉電源，則需要採取適當的步驟來保護您的物品。

🕒 如酒櫃處於無人看管狀態

在三星期或以內，請讓酒櫃持續運行。
如果該設備多於三個月不使用，請除去所有物品並關閉設備。徹底清潔並乾燥內部，以防止異味和黴菌滋生。請讓櫃門稍微打開進行通風，必要時將其打開。但注意需防止有兒童及動物爬入機內。

🕒 移動酒櫃

取出所有物品
取出酒櫃內的零散物品（例如酒架），或用物料固定。將可調式支腳向上旋轉至底座位置，以免損壞。用膠帶將櫃門關閉。
在運輸過程中，請確保將設備固定在直立位置。另外，用毯子或類似物品保護設備外部。


🕒 節能技巧

酒櫃應放置在房間較涼爽的区域，遠離會產生熱力設備，並避免陽光直射。
溫度設定時需按照酒類的特性，按適當的溫度設定以節省能源。

🕒 活性炭過濾網

活性炭過濾網位於隔間的背面，如妥善使用酒櫃，建議每年需要更換一次。它可以從零件部購買。

- 👉 卸下過濾網前面的酒架。
- 👉 握住過濾網，然後將其順時針或逆時針旋轉 90 度以將其取下。
- 👉 將新過濾網垂直插入，然後將其順時針或逆時針旋轉 90°，直至其植入到位。




